

Applying to the USM Digital Humanities Badge Program: A Step-by-Step Guide for non-USM graduate students

These directions are for graduate students enrolled in another university or those who have obtained their bachelor's degree but are not currently pursuing a graduate degree, and would like to pursue USM's Digital Humanities Badge

Step 1. Complete the online graduate application: <u>usm.edu/graduate-admissions/index.php#apply</u>

- Click the gold Apply button
- Create your application account (graduateadmissions.usm.edu/apply/)
- After verifying your email and signing into the portal, start an application
- On the "Enrollment Information" page, select "I am seeking admission to a degree, certificate, or badge program" option on the drop-down menu
- Select "yes" or "no" for the "Have you previously applied to, been admitted to, or enrolled at The University Southern Mississippi?" section
- Under "Major Field" options, select the "Digital Humanities Proficiency Badge" listed under the Humanities heading
- There is a \$60 application fee for applying to the DH Badge program

Step 2. After submitting your application, log back into your application portal to upload your Resume/CV, Statement of Purpose, and request official transcripts. (graduateadmissions.usm.edu/apply/).

Step 3. Once your application is complete it will be sent to the admissions committee for a final decision. You will be notified via email once a decision letter has been posted to your admissions portal.
